Points Cap Three Year Plan

Scaled reduction in quota cap will occur over three (3) seasons.

Ron Massey Cup

- 2024 Total Quota: 194 (17 players and a maximum 6 point 18th player)
- 2025 TBC after further testing
- 2026 TBC after further testing

Sydney Shield

- 2024 Total Quota: 90 (17 players and a maximum 6 point 18th player)
- 2025 TBC after further testing
- 2026 TBC after further testing

Note: Teams must field 17 players. If they field less than 17 for each player missing, they must deduct 12 points from the total cap value.

In 2025 NSWRL will introduce a scaled reduction in points to team allocations for the top 5 finish in the previous season. Full points to team allocation if finished in bottom half of the competition.

DISPENSATION

If a player gains an opportunity at a higher Pathways level, however, returns after 1 season, this player will maintain consecutive years at the same club and will not have an impact transfer. Players must be contracted to the higher pathways level in this example.

CLUB JUNIOR DEFINITION

Any Player who is registered in their most seasons of junior international level rugby league with the subject Club. Consideration by application to players that were at a club for seniors or junior.

Any Player who is registered in an equivalent number of seasons of junior international level rugby league with the subject Club and any other club but isregistered for their first season of senior rugby league with the subject Club.

Any Player who is registered in the most seasons of junior international level rugby league with a club that does not have a senior club participating in that competition will be allocated as per the affiliate club pathways determined by NSWRL.
