



2018 Harvey Norman NSWRL Women's Premiership Player Points Index System (PPIS)

| | Criteria | Points |
|---|--|--------|
| A | A player who has represented the Australian Jillaroos or NZ Kiwi Ferns | 20 |
| B | A player who has represented NSW or QLD in a Women's Interstate Match | 15 |
| C | A player who has participated in an 'All Stars' representative team or at the Auckland 9's Or A player who has represented nations other than Australia or New Zealand in an International fixture | 8 |
| D | A player transferring to a club from another NSWRL Women's Premiership club/team or equivalent (this does not apply where a District Team has replaced a Club team in the Competition) Or A player who has represented an Affiliated States representative team | 6 |
| E | A player transferring from a club outside their own District/Region which does not have a NSWRL Women's Premiership team or has ceased to have a NSWRL Women's Premiership team Or A player transferring from an Interstate or International Club not deemed equivalent to NSWRL Women's Premiership | 4 |
| F | An existing club player who did not fit into Category D or E upon joining the club Or A newly registered player who has not played Rugby League before | 0 |

Guidelines

- 1) Player indexes are not cumulative but will be calculated based on the player's **maximum PPI**
- 2) Points calculated using the players participating in that match only (Max 17)
- 3) Maximum Points Allowed per Team:
 - a) **Harvey Norman NSW Women's Premiership: 90 points** per team per match,
- 4) **Discounts** (Note: These discounts are cumulative to a maximum of 10 points discount BUT may not take a player's PPI below zero):
 - a) 1 point for each season a player has previously played with their current club
 - b) 1 point for each season since a player has been selected in a representative team (Cat A, B, C) OR for each season a player has not played Rugby League since playing for another club
 - c) 5 points for a Category A or B player who is selected in a representative team AFTER they have completed at least one season with their current club.

It is the responsibility of the club AND the player to ensure that the Assessment Sheet is properly completed and signed. Breaches shall apply for failure to comply with this requirement
An assessment sheet needs to be filled out for all new/transferring players to a club

Player Points Index System (PPIS) – Additional Considerations

Player Portability – Each NSWRL Women's Premiership club is to align themselves with a minimum of one local League club upon application to the NSWRL to facilitate the portability of players between Division 1 and Division 2 and enable the maximum number of players to participate each week.

- Players will be rated for PPIS purposes at the value given for the Primary Club they are registered for.
- Representative Players: Current Representative Players (Category A or B from 2017/2018) will not be allowed portability **downwards** from the Harvey Norman NSW Women's Premiership to Division 2
